A question I have: How would private, federal, and/or state grants to CalSWEC be found by people of normal reading and search abilities (high school, or basic college graduates living in the state? Does the average person know how to pore over the UC Berkeley's CAFR (financial statements), pick out what went in a given year to the School of Social Welfare from some set of financial statements, match it up with (here, just one is shown) the same year's — or decade's — private foundation support (donations) and come up with the numbers?

As with the "HMRF" (CFDA 93086) HHS funding as part of PRWORA, it was left to the highly motivated, very persistent, and very curious to even find out about CalSWEC's intentions toward the families and children of this entire state.
