- 1 **Ohio River Corridor Initiative (renamed Ohio River Way, Inc )** To provide start-up funding for the Ohio River Corridor Initiative (ORCI), a volunteer-driven effort to develop recreational, ecological, cultural and commercial opportunities for the Ohio River, one of the region's best assets GCF funds are requested to provide staff support to ORCI as it begins implementing a 5-year strategic plan. Amount of grant. \$500,000
- 2 **Health Foundation Fund:** To establish the Children's Behavioral Health Initiative, a funding collaborative aimed at improving the behavioral health of children in the region by making systemic changes that increase access to care and promote coordination of services, collaboration among providers, and efficient use of resources. Amount of grant: \$625,000
- 3 **United Way & Community Chest (renamed United Way of Greater Cincinnati):** To support the implementation of Success by 6, a community-wide process to identify desired high-level community outcomes and measurements, develop an action plan, and create and sustain the community determination and capability to make all children, ages 0 to 6, safe, healthy and successful Amount of grant \$500,000
- 4 **Fine Arts Fund:** To support a joint arts marketing initiative through the sponsorship of two festivals; the Festival of the New and the Festival of Freedom The goal of the festivals is to strengthen Cincinnati-based arts and cultural programs, build audiences, and raise their profile in the regional and national community The festivals will also celebrate civic pride and the diversity represented by Cincinnati's arts organizations Amount of grant \$200,000
