HHS Grant# D67MP94001 multi-year funding appears to be at least over 9 years; the first "NEW" Action not shown on HHS records going back to 1995. Principal Investigator reports it started 1994. Total Amount to Central State Univ. in Ohio under this CFDA via Dc67MP94001 and similar (but NOT identically) named grants, also multi-million-dollars and looking more like typos than actual grants, totals at least \$99M. Meanwhile, this University (which designation AS "university," its history page, only dates to 2004, has been put under state (OH Bd of Regents) fiscal watch since, and was in trouble also in the 1990s, during the time frame of these grants, acc. to other sources. The grant language (CFDA.gov) incl. a focus on MALE Minority Youth. The Principal Investigator (Laxley W. Rodney Ph.D.) has since showed up (along with co-author H.Elaine Rodney, Ph.D. **at Prairie Valley A&M University in TX, where a "College of Juvenile Justice and Psychology" was started up by the other co-author (Wife?)

**who, TAGGS.HHS.gov also shows as P.I. under different, separate (and much smaller) grants, which grants were in part to the OHIO state university, and in part to the TEXAS state university) and varied.
