The University consists of 12 schools - the Annenberg School for Communication, the School of Arts and Sciences, the School of Dental Medicine, the Graduate School of Education, the School of Engineering and Applied Science, the School of Design, the Law School, the Perelman School of Medicine, the School of Nursing, the School of Social Policy and Practice, the School of Veterinary Medicine, and the Wharton School.

So the Annenberg School for Communication is NOT a basic undergraduate college (see "Arts and Sciences"). I DNK the others, but the Wharton School is renowned (ASC is in good company).

Meanwhile over at the Graduate School of Education (GSE.Penn.edu I believe) is "FRPN.org" — Fatherhood Research and Practice Network ("cute...")

The University also is home to the University of Pennsylvania Health System, which includes the Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania (HUP), Pennsylvania Hospital, and the Penn Presbyterian Medical Center.
